AN ACT VALIDATING CERTAIN ACTION TAKEN AT THE ANNUAL TOWN MEETING OF THE TOWN OF NATICK IN THE YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-ONE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The action taken by the town of Natick at its
2 annual town meeting held on March twenty-third, nineteen
3 hundred and sixty-one, in voting, pursuant to Article forty-
4 seven of the warrant for said meeting, to pay to Roy E. Wy-
5 man the sum of four hundred and ten dollars as reimburse-
6 ment for medical and legal expenses incurred by him arising
7 out of an accident which occurred in the performance of his
8 duties as an employee of the public works department of said
9 town, and all acts done pursuant thereto while are hereby in
10 all respects ratified, validated and confirmed.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
