AN ACT TO VALIDATE THE ORGANIZATION OF THE TRUSTEES OF THE COLLEGE OF OUR LADY OF THE ELMS AND AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE CORPORATION CONCERNING ITS BORROWING POWER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Upon the making and filing of the certificate  
2 required by section thirteen of chapter one hundred and fifty-  
3 five of the General Laws, the organization of The Trustees of  
4 the College of Our Lady of the Elms, incorporated by chapter  
5 seven hundred and twnty of the acts of nineteen hundred  
6 and fifty-seven, is hereby validated, and all acts purporting  
7 to be acts of a corporation of that name are hereby ratified  
8 and confirmed as the legal acts of said corporation, provided  
9 that said certificate is made and filed within thirty days after  
10 the effective date of this act.

1 SECTION 2. Section 2 of chapter 720 of the acts of 1957  
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the third sentence the  
3 following sentence: — Said corporation shall have the power  
4 to borrow money, to issue bonds or notes or other evidences  
5 of indebtedness and to secure its indebtedness by mortgaging  
6 its real and personal estate or otherwise.
