## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Three.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO VENUE OF THE CRIME OF TRANSMITTING FALSE REPORTS OF THE LOCATION OF EXPLOSIVES OR OTHER DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 277 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after section 59 the following section: — *Section*  
3 *59A.* The crime described in section fourteen of chapter two  
4 hundred and sixty-nine may be prosecuted and punished in  
5 the territorial jurisdiction in which the communication orig-  
6 inates or is received.
