### AN ACT REGULATING THE USE OF THE WORD "NATIVE" IN CONNECTION WITH THE ADVERTISING OF VEGETABLES OR FRUIT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The first sentence of section 99B of chapter 94 of the Gen-  
2 eral Laws, as appearing in chapter 181 of the acts of 1962, is  
3 hereby amended by inserting after the word "native", in line  
4 3, the words: — nor cause vegetables or fruit to be advertised  
5 as "native".
