## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Three.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF SHREWSBURY TO SUPPLY AND SELL WATER TO 9-20, INC. FOR THE USE OF ITS MOTEL LOCATED IN THE TOWN OF NORTHBOROUGH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Shrewsbury is hereby authorized  
2 to supply and sell water to 9-20, Inc. for the use of its motel  
3 located in the town of Northborough; provided that said cor-  
4 poration bears any and all expenses arising out of the exten-  
5 sion of the water main and the installation of water service  
6 to its place of business. Water so furnished shall be sold at  
7 such rate or rates for this particular location and upon such  
8 terms as may be established by the board of selectmen of the  
9 town of Shrewsbury, acting as a board of water commis-  
10 sioners.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
