In The Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Three.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE QUESTION OF AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MEDFORD TO SELL CERTAIN PARK LAND IN SAID CITY SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS OF SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and fourteen of the acts
2 of nineteen hundred and sixty-three is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. There shall be placed upon the ballot to be
2 used at the regular municipal election in the current year in
3 the city of Medford the following question: — “Shall the city
4 of Medford, acting through its city council, with approval
5 of the city manager, be authorized to sell and convey all or
6 any part of a certain parcel of land in the city of Medford
7 held by the city for park purposes, containing approximately
8 fifty-six acres and located on Interstate Route 93 adjacent to
9 Wrights Pond?” If a majority of the votes in answer to said
10 question are in the affirmative, then the city of Medford, act-
11 ing through its city council, with the approval of the city
12 manager, may sell and convey all or may from time to time
13 sell and convey part, of a parcel of land in said city held for
14 park purposes, bounded and described as follows: —

15 Westerly, by Fellsway West and Interstate Route 93 taking
16 of October 31, 1958, about thirty-two hundred feet; Northerly,
17 by land of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Metropolitan
18 District Commission Water Works about fourteen hundred
19 feet; Easterly, by land of City of Medford along the westerly
20 sideline of Water Easement of the Commonwealth of Massa-
21 chusetts, Metropolitan District Commission and the westerly
22 water line of Wrights Pond about thirty-five hundred feet;
23 Southerly, by the northerly property line of various properties

24 on the northerly side of Parkway Road, Medford, about four
25 hundred feet.

26 Said parcel contains about 56 acres.

27 All as more particularly shown on plan, entitled "Wrights
28 Pond Reservation, Scale 1" = 200', October 18, 1962, Depart-
29 ment Planning, R. J. H., Revised November 14, 1962", on file
30 in the department of planning of the city of Medford.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
