AN ACT MAKING PERMANENT CERTAIN POSITIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to provide forthwith that certain
3 temporary positions in the department of public works be
4 made permanent, therefore it is hereby declared to be an
5 emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of
6 the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provisions of the general
2 appropriation act for the fiscal year nineteen hundred and
3 sixty-four or of any provision of any supplementary ap-
4 propriation act for said fiscal year, the number of permanent
5 positions of right of way negotiators in the department of
6 public works shall be increased to include eighty such posi-
7 tions, to be filled from the certified civil service list established
8 on June thirteenth, nineteen hundred and sixty-one.
