AN ACT MAKING PERMANENT CERTAIN POSITIONS IN THE CIVIL DEFENSE AGENCY.

1 *Whereas*, Federal contributions to the civil defense agency
2 may be discontinued if present temporary positions in said
3 agency are not made permanent forthwith, therefore this act
4 is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the
5 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Item 0406-01 of section 2 of chapter 500 of the acts of 1963
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "agency", in
3 line 1, the words: — , including not more than one hundred
4 and five permanent positions.
