AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BENEFITS UNDER THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW TO CERTAIN PERSONS UNEMPLOYED DUE TO A STOPPAGE OF WORK BECAUSE OF A LABOR DISPUTE IN ACTIVE PROGRESS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (b) of section 25 of chapter 151A of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 554 of the acts
3 of 1959, is hereby further amended by inserting after the
4 word "dispute", in line 3, the words: — in active progress.
