AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES TO FURNISH LISTS OF QUALIFIED STOCKS OR SECURITIES FOR SALE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 110A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 21 a new section 22: — *Section 22.*
- 3 The department upon application and payment of a fee of
- 4 \$100 per annum shall furnish to any applicant a list of stocks
- 5 or securities qualified for sale under this chapter and shall
- 6 furnish to said applicants a weekly supplement to said list
- 7 including any insertions or deletions thereof.
- 8 For the purpose of enforcing this section, the department
- 9 shall establish within its division of securities the position of
- 10 securities analyst.
