AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FEES TO BE PAID TO DENTISTS FOR SERVICES TO SUBSCRIBERS TO NON-PROFIT DENTAL SERVICE PLANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of chapter 176E of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out, in line 10, the words "equal to or", —
3 so that the fourth sentence will read as follows: — Such fees
4 shall not be higher than the fees charged by participating
5 dentists to their average non-subscriber patients; and in con-
6 sideration of said fees submitted for his approval, he shall
7 give weight to the ease and certainty of collection by the
8 participating dentists of said fees charged subscribers through
9 such corporation.
