AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMPUTATION OF THE AMOUNT OF SUPER-
ANNUATION RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE FOR EMPLOYEES UNDER THE
CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision (2) of section 5
2 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of
3 chapter 190 of the acts of 1961, is hereby amended by strik-
4 ing out, in line 8 and in line 12, respectively, the word "five"
5 and inserting in place thereof, in each instance, the word: —
6 two.

1 SECTION 2. Paragraph (c) of said subdivision (2), as so
2 appearing, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 5 and in
3 line 8, respectively, the word "five" and inserting in place
4 thereof, in each instance, the word: — two.

1 SECTION 3. Anything in subdivision (2) of section five of
2 chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, as amended by this
3 act, to the contrary notwithstanding, the retirement allowance
4 of any person who on the effective date of this act was a mem-
5 ber in service of a retirement system subject to sections one to
6 twenty-eight, inclusive, of said chapter thirty-two, shall in no
7 event be less than the retirement allowance provided by the
8 provisions of law in effect immediately prior to the effective
9 date of chapter six hundred and sixty-one of the acts of nine-
10 teen hundred and fifty-seven; nor shall the benefit of any bene-
11 ficiary of such person be less than the benefit so provided.
