By Mr. Kenneally, a petition of George V. Kenneally, Jr., and another for legislation to provide that creditable service for retirement purposes shall be allowed public employees for certain periods of absence due to educational leave. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR RETIREMENT PURPOSES SHALL BE ALLOWED PUBLIC EMPLOYEES FOR CERTAIN PERIODS OF ABSENCE DUE TO EDUCATIONAL LEAVE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after paragraph (m), added by chapter
3 584 of the acts of 1962, the following paragraph: — (n) Credit
4 shall be allowed for the actual period of time during which a
5 member is granted educational leave by his department head,
6 in accordance with the provision of any law authorizing such
7 leave; provided that such credit shall not be allowed for any
8 period of absence in excess of one year.
