AN ACT INCREASING THE MINIMUM PENSION OF CERTAIN  
RETIRED SCHOOL TEACHERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of general or special law  
2 to the contrary, any school teacher who was retired for or-  
3 dinary disability before nineteen hundred and fifty-five and  
4 who had at least twenty-five years of service at the time of  
5 retirement and who had never received an increase in pen-  
6 sion or retirement allowance during the ten-year period prior  
7 to January first, nineteen hundred and sixty-four and who is  
8 receiving a pension or retirement allowance of less than  
9 twenty-five hundred dollars per annum, shall have said pen-  
10 sion or allowance increased to twenty-five hundred dollars per  
11 annum.
