AN ACT CHANGING THE JOB GROUP CLASSIFICATIONS OF INVESTIGATORS FOR BOARD OF REGISTRATION OF BARBERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 40 of chapter 13 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 676 of the
3 acts of 1957, is hereby further amended by adding at the end
4 the following sentence: — No such investigator shall work in,
5 own or operate a barbershop, nor engage in any other em-
6 ployment or occupation or in any profession, practice or busi-
7 ness.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the
2 contrary, the director of personnel and standardization is
3 hereby authorized and directed to re-allocate the position of
4 investigator for the board of registration of barbers from job
5 group VII to job group XII, as established in subdivision (1)
6 of section forty-six of chapter thirty of the General Laws.
