AN ACT ESTABLISHING MINIMUM SALARIES FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 40 of Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the first sentence, as most recently
3 amended by Section 1 of Chapter 594 of the Acts of 1962, and
4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — The com-
5 pensation of every teacher employed in any public day school
6 in the Commonwealth, except persons in training and those
7 employed as temporary substitutes, shall be at a rate of not
8 less than five thousand dollars for the school year; after four
9 years, the compensation of such a teacher shall be at a rate
10 of not less than six thousand dollars, and, after ten years, such
11 compensation shall be at a rate of not less than seven
12 thousand five hundred dollars.
