AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE CLERK AND ASSISTANT CLERKS OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF BROOKLINE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Class IV of paragraph (1) of section 79 of
2 chapter 218 of the General Laws, as appearing in chapter
3 725 of the acts of 1962, is hereby amended by striking out
4 the line reading "municipal court of Brookline,".

1 SECTION 2. Class V of said paragraph (1) of said section
2 79 of said chapter 218, as amended by section 2 of chapter 841
3 of the acts of 1963, is hereby further amended by inserting
4 after line 6 the following line: — municipal court of Brookline,.
