RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE FEASIBILITY OF THE CONSOLIDATION OF ALL STATE AGENCIES HAVING JURISDICTION OVER OUTDOOR RECREATION ACTIVITIES INTO A STATE RECREATION BOARD OR DIVISION.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives, and five persons to be appointed by the governor, is
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation
5 and study of all state divisions, bureaus or commissions or
6 other public agencies having jurisdiction or control of any
7 outdoor recreational facilities in the commonwealth in order
8 to determine the feasibility of creating a single state agency
9 which would have control of planning, promoting and devel-
10 oping outdoor recreational facilities and administering such
11 activities. Said commission shall, in the course of its investi-
12 gation and study, cooperate with the Federal Bureau of Out-
13 door Recreation, and may accept any federal funds made avail-
14 able to it under Public Law 88-29.
