AN ACT EXEMPTING FROM TAXATION THE PROPERTY OF SURORDINATE LODGES AND THE GRAND LODGE OF INDEPENDENT ORDER OF ODD FELLOWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The real or personal property of any instru-
2 mentality or subdivision or lodge of the Massachusetts Grand
3 Lodge of Independent Order of Odd Fellows, whether such in-
4 strumentality is incorporated under the laws of this com-
5 monwealth or under the laws of any other state of the United
6 States, shall be exempt from taxation under the provisions of
7 chapter fifty-nine of the General Laws, so long as such prop-
8 erty is principally and usually devoted to the educational or
9 charitable purposes of said association.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of January first,
2 nineteen hundred and sixty-four.
