AN ACT PROVIDING THAT RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY TOWN BOARDS OR OFFICERS BE APPROVED BY THE VOTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 33 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 33A.* All rules or regulations made by town boards
- 4 or officers shall be approved by a majority vote of the voters at
- 5 an annual town meeting or by two-thirds of the voters at a
- 6 special town meeting before said rules or regulations become
- 7 effective.
