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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Four.

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### AN ACT LIMITING THE NUMBER OF TAXICAB LICENSES WHICH MAY BE ISSUED IN A CITY OR TOWN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 22E the following section: — *Section 22F.*
- 3 In a city or town which accepts this section the number of
- 4 taxicab licenses issued therein shall be limited to one for each
- 5 one thousand of population or fraction thereof.
- 6 The provisions of this section shall not apply to the city of
- 7 Boston.
