AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FITCHBURG TO APPROPRIATE AND PAY A SUM OF MONEY TO TRI-MARK CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Fitchburg is hereby authorized to
2 appropriate money for the payment of, and after said appro-
3 priation, the treasurer of said city is hereby authorized to pay
4 to Tri-Mark Construction Corporation for work and labor per-
5 formed in connection with the building of an elementary
6 school in the city of Fitchburg, a sum not exceeding eighteen
7 thousand eight hundred and seventy-four dollars and sixteen
8 cents, claim for which is legally unenforceable by reason of
9 being incurred in excess of available appropriations. The
10 money so appropriated to pay said claim shall be raised by
11 taxation, by loan order or made available from unappropriated
12 surplus funds of said city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the city of Fitchburg.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FITCHBURG TO BORROW MONEY AND TO ISSUE BONDS TO THE SAID PURPOSE.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, on the thirteenth day of February, A. D. 1887.

SECTION 1. The city of Fitchburg is hereby authorized to borrow money for the purpose of, and after said purpose, the purchase of said city is hereby authorized to issue bonds to the said city for the purpose of, and after said purpose, to be used in the city of Fitchburg, a sum not exceeding fifteen thousand eight hundred and eighty-four dollars and sixteen cents, plus for what is legally payable to the said city, being interest in excess of available expenditures. The said bonds shall be sold and shall be used for the purpose of, and after said purpose, to be used in the city of Fitchburg, a sum not exceeding fifteen thousand eight hundred and eighty-four dollars and sixteen cents, plus for what is legally payable to the said city, being interest in excess of available expenditures.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage by the city of Fitchburg.
