AN ACT MAKING A CORRECTIVE CHANGE IN THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE LICENSING OF RADIO AND TELEVISION TECHNICIANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 The second paragraph of section 87TTT of chapter 112 of
- 2 the General Laws, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 604
- 3 of the acts of 1963, is hereby amended by striking out, in
- 4 line 14, the words "filing of the copy of certificate herein-
- 5 before referred to" and inserting in place thereof the words: —
- 6 presentation to said board of the above mentioned copy or
- 7 certificate.
