## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF LICENSED LIQUID PROPANE INSTALLERS AS GAS INSPECTORS IN CERTAIN TOWNS NOT HAVING PIPED GAS AND IN WHICH A LICENSED PLUMBER OR A LICENSED GAS FITTER IS NOT AVAILABLE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 3 O of chapter 143 of the General Laws, inserted by
- 2 section 2 of chapter 737 of the acts of 1960, is hereby amended
- 3 by adding the following paragraph:—
- 4 A town which has only undiluted liquefied petroleum gas
- 5 available and which does not have a licensed plumber or
- 6 licensed gas fitter available for appointment as gas inspector,
- 7 may appoint a licensed undiluted liquefied petroleum gas in-
- 8 staller to inspect gas piping and gas appliances in buildings.
- 9 The appointing authority of such town shall certify to the
- 10 gas fitting regulatory board that only undiluted liquefied
- 11 petroleum gas is available in such town and that a licensed
- 12 plumber or licensed gas fitter is not available therein.
