AN ACT PROVIDING AN ALTERNATE METHOD OF DETERMINING CHARGES FOR STREET LIGHTING IN CITIES AND TOWNS HAVING MUNICIPAL LIGHT DEPARTMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 58 of chapter 164 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the fifth sentence, as appearing
3 in the Tercentenary Edition, the following sentence — In
4 addition to the method of determining charges for street
5 lighting in the preceding sentence, the electricity used by the
6 municipality for street lighting may be charged for at a cost
7 in accordance with a street lighting schedule filed with the
8 department.
