### AN ACT RELATING TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE CITIES AND TOWNS TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PROMOTE THEIR NATURAL RESOURCES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:*

1 Section 5 of chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out clause 51, as amended by chapter  
3 208 of the acts of 1959, and inserting in place thereof the fol-  
4 lowing clause: —

5 (51) For the purpose of establishing and maintaining a con-  
6 servation commission to promote the development and better  
7 utilization of the natural resources within the city or town.  
8 Money so appropriated in any year may be placed in a con-  
9 servation fund and allowed to accumulate from year to year,  
10 and may be expended by said commission for any purpose  
11 authorized by section eight C.
