AN ACT PERMITTING STATE POLICE OFFICERS TO RETIRE FOR ORDINARY DISABILITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3
2 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
3 striking out the definition of *Group 3*, as appearing in section
4 3 of chapter 321 of the acts of 1958, and inserting in place
5 thereof the following definition: — *Group 3*. — Officers and
6 inspectors of the division of state police in the department of
7 public safety referred to in section twenty-six, who shall be
8 retired and receive retirement allowances as provided for in
9 said section and in sections six and seven, anything in sec-
10 tions one to twenty-eight, inclusive, to the contrary notwith-
11 standing.

1 SECTION 2. Subdivision (1) of section 6 of said chapter
2 32 is hereby amended by striking out the words "Group 1 or
3 Group 2", inserted by section 10 of chapter 321 of the acts
4 of 1958, and inserting in place thereof the words: — Group 1,
5 Group 2 or Group 3.

1 SECTION 3. Subdivision (2) of said section 6 of said chap-
2 ter 32 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 18, the words
3 "Group 1 or Group 2", inserted by section 11 of said chapter
4 321, and inserting in place thereof the words: — Group 1,
5 Group 2 or Group 3.

1 SECTION 4. Said subdivision (2) of said section 6 of said
2 chapter 32, as amended by section 2, is hereby further
3 amended by adding at the end the following paragraph: —

4 (c) The normal yearly amount of such allowance for any
5 member classified in Group 3 other than a veteran as defined
6 in section one shall be equal to that to which he would be
7 entitled under the provisions of section twenty-six if he were
8 to be retired for superannuation upon the completion of
9 twenty years' service.
