## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF THE CLERKS OF THE FIRST DISTRICT COURT OF BRISTOL AND THE FOURTH DISTRICT COURT OF BRISTOL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Paragraph (1) of section 79 of chapter 218 of the General  
2 Laws is hereby amended in *Class III* by striking out line 1,  
3 inserted by section 1 of chapter 761 of the acts of 1962, and  
4 lines 3 and 4, as appearing in chapter 725 of the acts of 1962,  
5 and inserting in place thereof the following line: — The dis-  
6 trict court of Fitchburg, — and in *Class IV* by inserting after  
7 line 1, as appearing in said chapter 725 of the acts of 1962,  
8 the following line: — first district court of Bristol, — and  
9 by inserting after line 3, as so appearing, the following line: —  
10 fourth district court of Bristol, .
