AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF TUBERCULIN ON CATTLE AT
QUARANTINE STATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The first sentence of section 32 of chapter 129 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in section 54 of chapter 451 of the acts of
3 1939, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 4 and 5, the
4 words "at Brighton and Somerville".
