## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A YOUTH RECREATION COMMISSION FOR EACH OF THE TWENTY-TWO WARDS OF THE CITY OF BOSTON AND ESTABLISHING PROGRAMS FOR THE PREVENTION OF JUVENILE DELIN-QUENCY THEREIN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The city of Boston is hereby authorized to establish twenty-
- 2 two unpaid youth recreation commissions, one for each ward of
- 3 said city, to consist of parents who volunteer their services, and
- 4 who shall meet and organize for the purpose of establishing
- 5 programs to prevent juvenile delinquency. Said commissions
- 6 shall be a part of and work with any existing similar youth
- 7 agencies of said city. The total cost of said program shall not
- 8 exceed the sum of one hundred and fifty thousand dollars
- 9 annually, said sum to be distributed to each of the said wards
- 10 at the discretion of the mayor in accordance with the rate of
- 11 juvenile delinquency and the population of said wards.
