## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WORCESTER COUNTY TO BORROW MONEY TO ACQUIRE LAND AND TO CONSTRUCT THEREON AND ORIGINALLY EQUIP A NEW COURTHOUSE BUILDING FOR THE FIRST DISTRICT COURT OF SOUTHERN WORCESTER.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Worcester County  
2 are hereby authorized to acquire land within the judicial dis-  
3 trict of the first district of southern Worcester at a site to be  
4 determined by said commissioners and to construct thereon  
5 and originally equip a new courthouse building for said court.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose aforesaid the treasurer of said  
2 county, with the approval of the county commissioners, may  
3 borrow upon the credit of the county such sums as may be  
4 necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, five hundred thou-  
5 sand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the county there-  
6 for which shall bear on their face the words, First District  
7 Court of Southern Worcester Court House Loan, Act of 1966.  
8 Each authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan, and such  
9 loans shall be payable in not more than twenty years from their  
10 dates. The bonds or notes shall be signed by the county treas-  
11 urer and countersigned by a majority of the county commis-  
12 sioners. The county may sell the said securities at public or  
13 private sale, upon such terms and conditions as the county  
14 commissioners may deem proper, but not for less than their par  
15 value. Indebtedness incurred hereunder shall, except as herein

16 provided, be subject to chapter thirty-five of the General Laws.  
17 The county treasurer, with the approval of the county commis-  
18 sioners, may issue temporary notes of the county, payable in  
19 not more than one year from their date, in anticipation of the  
20 issue of serial bonds or notes under this act, but the time  
21 within which such serial bonds or notes shall become due and  
22 payable shall not, by reason of such temporary notes, be ex-  
23 tended beyond the time fixed by this act. Any notes issued in  
24 anticipation of the serial bonds or notes shall be paid from the  
25 proceeds thereof.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
