## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION, STUDY, AND THE DRAFTING OF APPROPRIATE LEGISLATION RELATIVE TO THE AMENDMENT OR COMPLETE REVISION OF THE ELECTION LAWS AND PROCEDURES OF THIS COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of  
2 two members of the senate appointed by the president, four  
3 members of the house of representatives appointed by the  
4 speaker, three persons appointed by the governor, one person  
5 appointed by the secretary of the commonwealth, one person  
6 appointed by the attorney general, two persons appointed by  
7 the president of the Massachusetts city clerks association and  
8 two persons appointed by the president of the Massachusetts  
9 town clerks' association, is hereby created to investigate, study,  
10 and draft appropriate legislation relative to the amendment or  
11 complete revision of the election laws and procedures of this  
12 commonwealth. The special commission may meet **with** or  
13 consult, without cost to the commonwealth, any persons rela-  
14 tive to this purpose. Said special commission shall report to  
15 the general court results of this investigation and study to-  
16 gether with the drafts of legislation necessary to carry its rec-  
17 ommendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk of  
18 the house of representatives on or before April 1, 1965.
