AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LICENSURE OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-  
2 serting after section 8A the following section: —  
3 *Section 8B.* A license issued under this chapter to operate a  
4 motor vehicle shall be deemed a right and not a privilege, and  
5 such right shall not be taken away by the registrar by the  
6 suspension or revocation of such license, except for violations  
7 set forth in this chapter and then only after (1) a finding of  
8 guilty by a court of competent jurisdiction, or (2) a hearing by  
9 the registrar.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE REGISTRATION FEES ON  
CERTAIN TRAILERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 33 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out subdivision (5), as amended by sec-  
3 tion 12 of chapter 679 of the acts of 1965, and inserting in  
4 place thereof the following subdivision: —

5 (5) For the registration of every trailer which is not leased  
6 or used in commerce, three dollars for every one thousand  
7 pounds or fraction thereof of the weight of such trailer and  
8 the maximum load to be carried thereon; and for the registra-  
9 tion of every trailer for which a fee is not otherwise provided  
10 in this section, six dollars for every one thousand pounds or  
11 fraction thereof of the weight of such trailer and the maxi-  
12 mum load to be carried thereon.
