AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE GROUP INSURANCE COMMISSION TO ESTABLISH A SELF-INSURANCE PROGRAM IN LIEU OF THE PRESENT SYSTEM FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 4 of chapter 32A of the General Laws, as most re-
- 2 cently amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto
- 3 the following paragraph: —
- 4 The commission, if it deems it to be in the best interests of
- 5 the commonwealth and its employees, may establish a self-
- 6 insurance program for the employees of the commonwealth.
