In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE SALARY OF THE JUSTICE OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF DUKES COUNTY AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH JUSTICE SHALL DEVOTE FULL TIME TO THE DUTIES OF THE OFFICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 77A of chapter 218 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by section 14 of chapter 810 of the
3 acts of 1963, is hereby further amended by inserting after
4 the first paragraph the following paragraph: —

5 The salary of the justice of the district court of Dukes
6 County shall be ten thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. Section 78 of said chapter 218, as most recently
2 amended by section 16 of said chapter 810 of the acts of 1963,
3 is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 30 to 32,
4 inclusive, the words "the salary of the justice of the district
5 court of Dukes County shall be sixty-six hundred and twenty-
6 five dollars;".

1 SECTION 3. The first paragraph of section 77B of said chap-
2 ter 218, as appearing in section 15 of said chapter 810 of the
3 acts of 1963, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 7 and
4 8, the words "section seventy-eight" and inserting in place
5 thereof the words: — sections seventy-seven A and seventy-
6 eight, respectively.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect on January first, nine-
2 teen hundred and sixty-seven.
