## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE SALARY OF THE SHERIFF OF SUFFOLK COUNTY, AND THE SALARIES OF COURT OFFICERS IN ATTENDANCE UPON THE SUPERIOR COURT IN SUFFOLK COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The first sentence of section 49 of chapter 35  
2 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1  
3 of chapter 841 of the acts of 1963, is hereby further amended  
4 by inserting after the word "Suffolk", in line 10, the words: —  
5 , the sheriff of the county of Suffolk.

1 SECTION 2. Section 17 of chapter 37 of the General Laws  
2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph: — The  
3 salary of the sheriff of the county of Suffolk shall be thirteen  
4 thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 3. Section 73 of chapter 221 of the General Laws,  
2 as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 766 of the  
3 acts of 1963, is hereby further amended by adding the follow-  
4 ing sentence: — Each officer in attendance upon the superior  
5 court in Suffolk county who is appointed under section seventy  
6 of chapter two hundred and twenty-one shall receive from said  
7 county in full for all services performed by him a salary equiv-  
8 alent to seventy per cent of the salary of the sheriff of said  
9 county; except that such officer designated to act as chief  
10 deputy sheriff shall receive a salary equivalent to eighty per  
11 cent of the salary of said sheriff, the officer designated as as-  
12 sistant chief deputy sheriff shall receive a salary equivalent

13 to seventy-eight per cent of the salary of said sheriff, the officer  
14 in charge of jurors' assembly rooms shall receive a salary  
15 equivalent to seventy-six per cent of the salary of said sheriff,  
16 the assistant to the officer in charge of the juror's assembly  
17 rooms shall receive a salary equal to seventy-five per cent of  
18 the salary of said sheriff and the officer commissioned as depu-  
19 ty sheriff to supervise the work of other officers and perform  
20 other related matters in the disposition session of the criminal  
21 court shall receive a salary equivalent to seventy-six per cent  
22 of the salary of said sheriff.

1 SECTION 4. Section two of chapter seven hundred and sixty-  
2 six of the acts of 1963 is hereby repealed.
