AN ACT REALLOCATING THE POSITIONS OF BARBER AND BEAUTICIAN IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE COMMONWEALTH FROM JOB GROUP VI TO JOB GROUP IX.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The positions of barber and beautician in the classified service of the commonwealth shall be reallocated from job group 2 VI to job group IX.
