AN ACT PROVIDING THAT SOCIAL SECURITY PAYMENTS SHALL NOT BE CONSIDERED AS INCOME OF AN APPLICANT FOR EXEMPTION UNDER THE LAW PROVIDING A TAX ABATEMENT FOR CERTAIN ELDERLY PERSONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Clause Forty-first of section 5 of chapter 59 of the General  
2 Laws, as amended by section 1 of chapter 681 of the acts of  
3 1964, is hereby further amended by adding at the end the fol-  
4 lowing sentence: — In computing the net income of an appli-  
5 cant for exemption under this clause any payments received  
6 by him under the federal social security law shall not be con-  
7 sidered as income.
