In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CERTAIN CORPSMEN OF  
THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 121 of chapter 6 of the General Laws,  
2 inserted by section 2 of chapter 622 of the acts of 1964, is  
3 hereby amended by adding the following paragraph: — There  
4 are hereby established one hundred scholarships in the  
5 amount of two hundred dollars each to be granted annually  
6 by the commission to student corpsmen who are attending  
7 institutions of higher learning certified by the department of  
8 education and who devote full time to their duties during the  
9 months of June, July and August.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July first, nineteen  
2 hundred and sixty-six.
