The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Six.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE COMMONWEALTH REIMBURSE ERNEST T. CUNNINGHAM, ASSISTANT SECRETARY AND INVESTIGATOR OF THE BOARD OF STATE EXAMINERS OF PLUMBERS, FOR THE COST OF LEGAL SERVICES INCURRED BY HIM IN DEFENSE OF CERTAIN CRIMINAL CHARGES AGAINST HIM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 There shall be allowed and paid out of the state treasury,
2 subject to appropriation, to Ernest T. Cunningham of Needham
3 the sum of five thousand dollars as reimbursement for the
4 cost of legal services incurred by him in defense of criminal
5 charges brought against him, as assistant secretary and an in-
6 vestigator of the board of state examiners of plumbers, for
7 alleged violations of law, and of which he was acquitted in
8 June, nineteen hundred and sixty-two.
