AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME WITHIN WHICH WIDOWS OF CERTAIN FIRE FIGHTERS AND MINOR CHILDREN OF CERTAIN POLICE OFFICERS AND FIRE FIGHTERS MAY FILE APPLICATION FOR CERTAIN ABATEMENTS OR EXEMPTIONS OF TAXES LEVIED IN THE YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FIVE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

1 Application for abatement of exemption by widows of fire
2 fighters, as provided in clause Forty-second of section 5 of
3 chapter 59 of the General Laws, and by surviving minor
4 children of police officers or fire fighters, as provided in clause
5 Forty-third of said section 5 of said chapter 59, of taxes
6 levied in the year nineteen hundred and sixty-five may be
7 made not later than October first, nineteen hundred and
8 sixty-six, notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary.
