AN ACT REQUIRING THE AMOUNTS OF MONEY CONTRIBUTED TO CANDIDATES FOR STATE-WIDE OFFICE BY PERSONS HAVING A FINANCIAL INTEREST IN CONSULTANT'S CONTRACTS TO BE CONTAINED IN THE CONSULTANT'S AFFIDAVIT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 7 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
2 out section 14A, inserted by chapter 844 of the acts of 1963,
3 and inserting in place thereof the following section: —
4 *Section 14A.* No contract to provide consultant services
5 shall be awarded by the commonwealth, or by any department,
6 board, commission or other agency acting in its behalf, unless
7 the person signing such contract on behalf of the party con-
8 tracting to provide such services files with the comptroller a
9 statement under the penalties of perjury setting forth the
10 names and addresses of and the amounts of money contributed
11 in the preceding state election to each candidate and commit-
12 tees in his behalf for an office to be filled by all the voters of
13 the commonwealth by all persons having a financial interest
14 therein, not including, however, any person whose only fi-
15 nancial interest therein consists of the holding of one per cent
16 or less of the capital stock of a corporation contracting to pro-
17 vide such services.
