SENATE, August 25, 1966.

1 *Ordered*, That the Committee on State Administration be  
2 authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court for  
3 the purpose of making an investigation and study of the sub-  
4 ject matter of current senate document numbered 963, a report  
5 of the committee on Public Welfare authorized (under Senate  
6 Order No. 813 of 1966) to make an investigation and study  
7 relative to the administration and extension of services of  
8 the public welfare system of the Commonwealth.

9 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state  
10 house or elsewhere, may hold public hearings, may travel  
11 within the Commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and  
12 other services and expenses such sums as may be appropriated  
13 therefor. Said committee shall report to the General Court  
14 the results of its investigation and study, and its recommenda-  
15 tions, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to  
16 carry such recommendations into effect, by filing the same  
17 with the Clerk of the Senate on or before March one nine-  
18 teen hundred and sixty-seven.
