In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT SCHOOL LUNCHROOMS SERVE CERTAIN
MEALS TO ELDERLY PERSONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. In cities and towns in which the school com-
2 mittee prepares and sells lunches at school buildings for the
3 pupils and teachers of the public schools, the school committee
4 shall serve hot meals to elderly persons at a reduced rate at
5 least two school days each week from four o'clock post meri-
6 dian to seven o'clock post meridian.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be effective only for the school
2 year commencing in September, nineteen hundred and sixty-
3 seven.
