In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GRADING AND LABELLING OF MILK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 13B of Chapter 94 of the General Laws as most
2 recently amended by Section 1, Chapter 263 of the Acts of
3 1933 is hereby further amended by striking out the words
4 "sections thirteen and thirteen A" in the first sentence and
5 inserting therein the words "section thirteen" so that the
6 sentence shall read as follows:—Any person selling milk
7 graded as described in the rules and regulations adopted and
8 approved under section thirteen, or amended from time to
9 time under authority thereof, in addition to such labelling as
10 may be required, may state upon the package in which such
11 milk is contained the state wherein such milk was produced,
12 provided that all the milk contained in such package so
13 labelled was produced exclusively in one state.
