AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LABELLING AND SALE OF MILK.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 13C of Chapter 94 of the General Laws as most  
2 recently amended by Section 1 of Chapter 263 of the Acts of  
3 1933 is hereby further amended by striking out the words  
4 "sections thirteen and thirteen A" in the first sentence and  
5 inserting therein the words "section thirteen" so that the  
6 sentence shall read as follows: — Except as otherwise pro-  
7 vided in section thirteen D, whoever sells or offers for sale  
8 any milk of any grade other than one established under au-  
9 thority of section thirteen, or labels or sells or offers for sale  
10 any milk labelled in imitation of any grade so established,  
11 shall be punished by a fine of not more than fifty dollars.
