
By Mr. Kelly, a petition of James A. Kelly, Jr., for legislation to authorize the county commissioners of Worcester County to borrow money for constructing, equipping and furnishing a new court house in the town of Webster for the First District Court of Southern Worcester. Counties.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WORCESTER COUNTY TO BORROW MONEY FOR CONSTRUCTING, EQUIPPING AND FURNISHING A NEW COURT HOUSE IN THE TOWN OF WEBSTER FOR THE FIRST DISTRICT COURT OF SOUTHERN WORCESTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of providing adequate court
2 house accommodations and facilities for the first district court
3 of southern Worcester, the county commissioners of the
4 county of Worcester may construct, in the town of Webster,
5 equip and furnish a suitable building.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose aforesaid, the treasurer of said
2 county, with the approval of the county commissioners, may
3 borrow upon the credit of the county such sums as may be
4 necessary, not exceeding in the aggregate, two hundred thou-
5 sand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes of the county
6 thereof, which shall bear on their face the words, Worcester
7 County Court House Loan, First District Court of Southern
8 Worcester, Act of 1967. Each authorized issue shall constitute
9 a separate loan and such loans shall be payable not more than
10 ten years from their dates. The bonds or notes shall be signed
11 by the county treasurer and countersigned by a majority of
12 the county commissioners. The county may sell the said
13 securities at public or private sale, upon such terms and condi-
14 tions as the county commissioners may deem proper, but not

15 for less than their par value. Indebtedness incurred hereunder
16 shall, except as herein provided, be subject to chapter thirty-
17 five of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 3. The county treasurer of said county, with the
2 approval of the county commissioners, may issue temporary
3 notes of the county, payable in not more than one year from
4 their dates, in anticipation of the issue of serial bonds or notes
5 under this act, but the time within which such serial bonds or
6 notes shall become due and payable shall not, by reason of such
7 temporary notes, be extended beyond the time fixed by this
8 act. Any notes issued in anticipation of the serial bonds or
9 notes shall be paid from the proceeds thereof.
