RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION CONCERNING FLOOD CONTROL OF THE MUDDY RIVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Resolved, that the Metropolitan District Commission is
- 2 hereby authorized and directed to investigate and make a
- 3 study of the necessity of action being taken for flood control
- 4 of the Muddy River in the Boston-Brookline area and in con-
- 5 ducting said investigation shall consult with other agencies 6 both state and federal which may be concerned especially the
- 7 Department of the Army, New England Division, Corps of
- 8 Engineers which has prepared a study entitled "Reconnais-
- 9 sance Report Local Protection, Muddy River, Boston-Brook-
- sance Report Local Protection, Muddy River, Boston-Brook-
- 10 line, Massachusetts" and the Department of Public Works of
- 11 the Commonwealth which has the responsibility to coordi-
- 12 nate the design and means of carrying the Muddy River under
- 13 the Inner Belt Highway. Said commission shall report to the
- 14 general court the results of its investigation and study, and
- 15 its recommendations, together with drafts of legislation neces-
- 16 sary to carry such recommendations into effect, by filing
- 17 the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or
- 18 before the last Wednesday in , nineteen hun-
- 19 dred and sixty-seven.
