By Mr. Hammond, a petition of George D. Hammond for legislation to require the construction by the Department of Public Works of outdoor swimming pools in the city of Westfield and the town of West Springfield. Harbors and Public Lands.

AN ACT REQUIRING THE CONSTRUCTION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OF OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOLS IN THE CITY OF WESTFIELD AND THE TOWN OF WEST SPRINGFIELD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby authorized and
2 directed to construct and maintain an outdoor swimming pool
3 and dressing rooms in the city of Westfield and in the town
4 of West Springfield. For the purpose of such construction,
5 said department may expend such sums as may be available
6 under the provisions of chapter six hundred and forty-eight
7 of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
