AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE OPERATION BY NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF MOTOR VEHICLES REGISTERED IN ANOTHER STATE OR COUNTRY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first sentence of section 3 of chapter 90 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 463 of the acts of
3 1953, is hereby amended by adding the following — ; and pro-
4 vided, further, that no non-resident enrolled as a student at a
5 school or college in the commonwealth shall operate a motor
6 vehicle registered in another state or country for more than
7 thirty days in the aggregate within the commonwealth during
8 any period beginning on September first of any year and end-
9 ing on August thirty-first of the following year.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 3 of said chapter 90 is hereby
2 further amended by striking out the third paragraph, inserted
3 by section 2 of chapter 19 of the acts of 1962.
